Prayer Ceremony for a Successful Rocket Launch at a World Heritage Temple



A prayer ceremony for the success of the rocket launch will be held at Fudarakusanji Temple, part of the World Heritage "Sacred Sites and Pilgrimage Routes in the Kii Mountain Range". After a rare viewing of the temple's hidden statue of the Eleven-Faced Kannon, a Goma fire ceremony will take place, offering a spiritual connection between Kumano's sacred land and outer-space.

On the evening after the rocket launch, enjoy a special BBQ party and film viewing at the majestic Ichimai iwa, a nationally designated natural monument. The sheer rock face, 100 meters tall and 400 meters wide, was born from one of Earth's largest volcanic eruptions Enjoy a variety of local ouisine, and relive the excitement of the rocket launch in a unique film projection on the rock face. This exclusive event brings different elements together to create a memorable evening of bonfires and starry skies.

Build and Launch Your Own Rocket



On the final day, you will have the opportunity to experience launching your very own rocket. Each participant starts by building a small personal rocket. Then, everyone will construct an Alpha ill model rocket powered by solid fuel, using the same mechanisms as the real thing. Watch the launch from the Shimizu Pass on the Kumano Kodo, a sacred ancient pilgrimage route connecting the regions of Kushimoto and Nachikatsuura. This unique experience combines modern space exploration with the spiritual significance of the Kumano region. Being able to watch a rocket soar into the sky from the heart of nature is a truly extraordinary experience.

Water Course: Private cruise to the closest viewing point for the rocket launch

Enjoy the launch from the privately chartered ship "Kairos No. 2". From the sea, you'll get the closest view of the rocket's ascent, feel the vibrations of its powerful engines, and witness the white smoke trail from up close.

Onsen Course : Private open-air bath at KOUBOUYU

Experience the launch while relaxing in a private open air bath at the KOUSOUYU onsennear the famous Hashigui Rooks. Enjoy the serene ocean view from your partially-covered bath while watching the rocket launch. This offers a luxurious and u nique way to enjoy the event, accompanied by views of the stunning Pacific Ocean.

In case of bad weather or other unforeseen circumstances that prevent viewing from the Fire.Water, or Onsen courses, we will arrange alternate soating at a special viewing area closest to the official Jaunch site.

Special Viewing Seats on the Rooftop of the Former Uragami Elementary School The rooftop of the former Uragami Elementary School, provides an exclusive vantage point closest to the official viewing site. The area will also feature food and drink stalls, offering a premium experience while you take in the rocket's powerful ascent.
